


Numbers in Sentences

- 19% of all students at the Leibniz University Hannover are studying with the goal of becoming a teacher.
- 6% of all students are enrolled in Master degrees in the field of Teacher Education.
- 88% of all students who are enrolled in the Interdisciplinary Bachelor Degree, who have passed their final examination within the period of WiSe 2018/19 until SuSe 2021 have completed a school internship.
- 97% of all students of the Bachelor's degree Special Education, who have passed their final examination within the period of WiSe 2018/19 until SuSe 2021 have completed a school internship.
- The biggest percentage of Teacher Education students are enrolled in the Faculty of Humanities with 62%.
- The highest proportion of female students are enrolled in the Special Education degree programmes, with 81% of female students in the Bachelor's and 88% in the Master's programme.
- 23% of LUH's total teaching effort goes into the Master's degree courses in Teacher Education and into the polyvalent Bachelor Degree Course.
- The highest teaching effort for Teacher Education is carried out by the Faculty of Humanities with 71%.

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

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




Students of Faculties involved in Teacher Education according to Teaching Units and Degrees





Bachelor Special Education**





Teacher Education Percentage of the FTE


In order to differentiate student full-time equivalents (FTE) with and without the teacher education option in the Interdisciplinary Bachelor degree and the Bachelor Special Education, the percentage of graduates (three-year average) from each degree programme who have completed a school internship were included. The thus-calculated Teacher Education FTE was then compared to the total number of FTE (but excluding students on leave of absence and doctoral candidates) per teaching unit and faculty.

Percentage of Teacher Education students*




Final Examinations completed by Teacher Education Students*
